
Book-Match Feature Wall Layout Guide

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Intended readers: shop-drawing designers / installers

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What Is Book-Match

Two adjacent slabs are opened like mirrored pages, so the veining forms a symmetric spread. A four-panel layout (book-match ×2) creates a continuous symmetric pattern — the classic grammar of luxury feature walls.

Three Preparations Before Layout

Slab scanning: HD-scan and model the whole batch for digital layout previews.

Veining axis: fix the dominant veining direction (horizontal / vertical / radial) — it defines the symmetry axis.

Block continuity: adjacent slabs from the same block book-match best; cross-block matching must accept variation.

The Five-Step Digital Layout Method

① Scan and archive → ② model the wall at 1:1 → ③ digital trial assembly (compare alternatives) → ④ client approves the rendering → ⑤ cut, number and pack to the approved plan (back labels + installation map).

Installation and Lighting

Install in numbering order; joint misalignment ≤ 0.5 mm. Pair the wall with wall-washer lighting and fine-tune on site to verify the veining layers.
